HIT AND MISS

I have for a long time felt (in fun) that if compound archers only shoot gold 10s and 9s that they should only be given those colours to shoot at and leave the other perfectly good colours for me to shoot.

It seems that there is an exciting movement toward a form of archery called HIT AND MISS which is sweeping the world.

The target face offers gold and red rings on a blue back ground.

As I understand it, the hit zone is the 10 cm gold circle and gets you one point everything else is a miss with the 30 cm red circle being to help aiming and the blue just to add colour. (feel free to add to this explanation) I am sure this will have many supporters as well as distracters but it is certainly creating a lot of interest.

A Hit and Miss event was held in Augsburg Germany 24 April 2010 to show the new format and seems to have been very successful the new format is also to be trialed at world events in the near future so it seems it may be something we will see in the future.

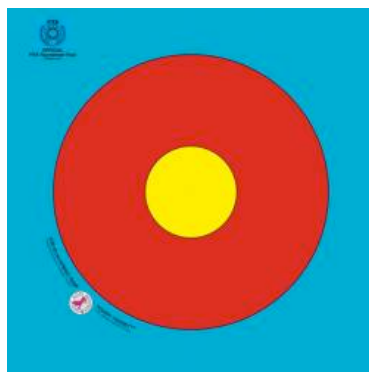
Target faces are available from Quicks Archery England but are probably available from other outlets also.

THE INAUGURAL YOUTH OLYMPIC GAMES.

The inaugural Youth Olympic games will be held in Singapore this year

The games will include educational and cultural activities and is the initiative of the IOC.
